

Bulletin updated at 19:45 HKT 15 Apr 2012 by HKWCS

Overview:

A trough of low pressure has already formed over the northern Guangdong. Thundery showers associated with the trough is now affecting the region. Shaoguan, one of the cities located in northern Guangdong, has been hit by hail when the city was being affected by squally thunderstorm in the afternoon. The aforementioned trough will gradually move southward and bring unsettled weather to the coastal areas of southern China in the next few days. Hong Kong today was mainly cloudy with sunny periods. The maximum temperature of most districts rose up to around 30 degrees in the afternoon.

Forecast:

Mainly cloudy with shower patches. Moderate southerly to southwesterly wind. Temperature will range between 25 and 29 degrees.

Outlook:

There will be scattered thundery showers in the coming two days. Since heavy rain is expected on both Thursday and Friday, the possibility of issuing the first rainstorm signal of the year cannot be ruled out.
